'Moving Up' Day

All Nursery children will experience their new classroom with their fellow classmates, teachers and class support. On the day every child can also experience a school dinner with a free school meal.

Our usual wrap around care will be available on the day.

Also, on Wednesday 8th July 2026, you and your child are invited to come into school and meet Mrs Lovell the Reception teacher and see for yourselves the area your child will be working in, come September. This is a very informal session and an opportunity for you to discuss arrangements and have an opportunity to ask any questions you may have. This session will be held between 3:30pm and 4:30pm.

- An information booklet with important information about starting full time school.
- Fun activities you can do together and some equipment to help you get started.
- Forms to fill in which you will need to complete and return to school via the school email address.
